

New Cedarvale Park bridge reaches destination

Georgetown-based S&S Transport delivered a 26-ton bridge from a manufacturer in Barrie on Friday morning to Cedarvale Park to replace the old bridge near the community centre.

OPP and Halton Regional Police helped escort the 17x56-foot bridge along Hwy. 407 to Trafalgar Rd., then north to Maple Ave. in Halton Hills before reaching its destination just off Main St.

The trip was delayed briefly by thunderstorms Friday morning but arrived around noon, three hours after leaving Barrie.

It's expected that the new bridge will be put into place on Monday.
